Supplement to the 2015 Annual Report Conditions of Operating, Vancouver Coastal Health Authority

2. Changes to operational staff: There were no changes in operational staff

3. Significant issues: All significant issues remain tied to budgetary constraints.

4. Turbidity events - There were 9 turbidity events recorded in 2015. Two we consider severe; Mar 26th lasted a day and a half and reached a turbidity level of 59 points greater than 40 NTU, and October 17th, while short in duration, exceeded 100 points greater than 40 NTU. A detailed report of the readings is attached.

1) Feb. 13 th – about 4 hrs.	6) Sept 19 th – about 1 ½ hrs.

5. Capital Projects –
 - a. A well for backup water supply during turbidity events was not brought online until May 2016.
 - b. Commercial POE units were being held pending the connection of the well.

6. Compliance to the DWPA and Regulations – An Interim report for the POE Pilot Project, completed in the spring of 2016 is included with this report.
